Dear Mr. Schleyer:

I understand that Adelphia Communications Corporation is currently renegotiating contracts with a number of units of the Communications Workers of America (CWA) nationwide and that two of these units are located in Virginia in or near the Ninth Congressional District which I represent.

The unit located in Martinsville, Virginia, is working to renegotiate a contract with Adelphia that expired on August 7, 2004, and the first post-contract negotiation took place recently on August 18. The Norton, Virginia, unit is attempting to renegotiate a contract with Adelphia that expired on December 31, 2002. A post contract negotiation took place in January, 2004 and another is scheduled for September 10, 2004. In both instances the employees are continuing to work without a contract.

I understand that the Communication Workers of America bargaining units are interested in resolving the issues surrounding the contract negotiations in a timely and satisfactory fashion. I urge Adelphia to negotiate with the CWA in good faith and to conclude these negotiations in a timely manner.
