## NABET-CWA/NBCU NEGOTIATIONS NEW YORK CITY

Representatives of NABET-CWA and NBC Universal met throughout the week of September 22, 2008, in New York City, in off-the-record sessions, as they began negotiations for an agreement to succeed the one scheduled to expire on March 31, 2009. Once again, the parties have agreed to limit the issues discussed in an attempt to reach an early resolution of the talks.

The Union was represented at the bargaining table by Ed McEwan and Larry Worster (New York, Local 11), Rich McDermott (Washington, D.C., Local 31), Ed Dabrowski (Chicago, Local 41), Steve Ross (Burbank, CA, Local 53), NABET-CWA President John S. Clark and NABET-CWA Vice President Jim Joyce.

Among the issues discussed during the week of bargaining were jurisdiction and future work opportunities, training, Daily Hires, wages and other economic terms, seniority, buy-outs, and vacation scheduling.

The parties will resume these off-the-record, limited issue negotiations on October 20, 2008, in New York City.
