## NABET-CWA/NBCU NEGOTIATIONS NEW YORK CITY

Representatives of NABET-CWA and NBC Universal met throughout the week in New York City as they resumed negotiations for an agreement to succeed the one scheduled to expire on March 31, 2009.

Talks this week centered on reviewing both Union and Company proposals made in the prior rounds of negotiations. In addition, the Union submitted a number of information requests concerning Company proposals on jurisdiction and seniority.

Throughout the week, Union negotiators repeatedly told NBCU representatives that our members are major contributors to the continued success of the Company, even in these challenging economic times, and are not interested in being marginalized.

The Union is represented at the bargaining table by Ed McEwan and Larry Worster (New York, Local 11), Rich McDermott (Washington, D.C., Local 31), Ray Taylor (Chicago, Local 41), Steve Ross (Burbank, CA, Local 53), NABET-CWA President John S. Clark and NABET-CWA Vice President Jim Joyce.

The NABET-CWA Negotiating Committee will caucus throughout the weekend. The parties are scheduled to meet throughout the coming week.
