NABET-CWA/NBCU NEGOTIATIONS NEW YORK CITY

The 2006-2009 NABET-CWA/NBC Universal Master Agreement expired at midnight last night without the parties reaching an agreement on a successor contract. Although the Company and the Union have made some progress on a number of issues since bargaining resumed on March 16, no significant progress was made on critical issues such as seniority, future job security, or wages.

Further talks are currently scheduled for the end of this month, and the parties have agreed to keep the lines of communication open during this hiatus. By law, most of the terms of the expired contract remain in effect. Members should continue to report to work as usual.

The Union's bargaining committee will be communicating with the membership in more detail shortly, and local membership meetings will be scheduled. Remember: Unity among all our members now is a vital key to our future success in these negotiations.

Further bulletins and other official information concerning these negotiations will be distributed by the Sector and Locals as necessary. In the meantime, please ignore all rumors.
