## NABET-CWA/NBCU NEGOTIATIONS

Please be advised that the NABET-CWA-represented employees of NBC Universal have overwhelmingly approved the Network Negotiating Committee's request for strike authorization.

The vote, which was conducted separately by secret ballot in New York, Washington, D.C.; Chicago and Burbank between June 22 and July 13, was tabulated on Tuesday, July 14, 2009. The membership at each location passed the strike authorization by a large margin.

Your Network Negotiating Committee (NNC) appreciates your continued faith, trust and support, and will now return to the task of mobilizing to achieve a fair and equitable contract that fits both the needs of our membership and those of NBC Universal. The NNC pledges to use this strike authorization with wisdom and restraint, and always in the best interests of the membership we represent.

The NNC is planning to meet in caucus in New York City at the end of July, and will keep you advised of any changes or progress in our negotiations with NBC Universal. As always, please ignore all rumors.
