Bargaining is tough. Your bargaining team will sit across the table from AT&T and will work hard to make your issues clear to the company. But the bottom line is this: AT&T is a big, powerful company that wants to give you as little as they can.

Your issues. Your Union conducted a survey and you were united on what the key issues are: fair wages, protecting your benefits, job security, protections against subcontracting, a transfer plan, improved scheduling and time-off, and more. Now we need to be united to achieve them.
