
Dear Annie,

We have seen a 95 percent reduction in new AIDS cases in children in the United States, and a 50 percent reduction in new infections in children around the world. The Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation (EGPAF) has been a major contributor to this achievement, and just recently celebrated having reached more than 20 million pregnant women with HIV services to prevent transmission to their babies.
